## Sunday Morning Worship

Our nursery is staffed during worship and is available for children, newborn to 3 years old.

Children's church, for children preschool age through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, dismisses during worship immediately after the children's message. This opportunity is for them to gather for their own time to worship God through story, song, and creative activities.

Following worship and fellowship time, Sunday School classes for children and youth will meet downstairs.

- For children 4 years old through 5<sup>th</sup> grade, our Sunday School is "Faith Quest – Growing faith while having fun!"
- For youth in 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade, we are studying the book of Ephesians.
